
IB mission statement

Introduction

Founded in 1968, the IB currently works with 3,671 schools in 146 countries to develop and offer four challenging programmes to over 1,134,000 students aged 3 to 19 years.

Since 1983, the IB has been recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as an entry qualification (equivalent to + 2 qualification of an Indian Board) to all universities in India. The IB is committed to supporting the large proportion of students who wish to remain in India for their undergraduate studies and creating pathways to enable more students (including NRIs) to consider this option.


This aim of this booklet is to provide an overview of university recognition in India with statements and website links of universities in India with updated polices. This is a guide for all stakeholders to understand the recognition landscape in India. As higher education institutions in the India respond to the growth of the IB, the booklet will be updated on a regular basis.




Asia Pacific and India IB programme distribution

In the Asia Pacific region, there are more than 600 schools in 29 countries offering one or more of the three IB programmes: 404 schools offer the Diploma Programme (DP); 135 schools offer the Middle Years Programme (MYP), and 305 schools offer the Primary Years Programme (PYP). The distributions of the three programmes in the 29 countries in Asia Pacific are listed below (Chart 1).

There are 107 IB World Schools in India offering one or more of the three IB programmes. 47 schools offer the Primary Years Programme, 11 schools offer the Middle Years Programme and 92 schools offer the Diploma Programme. The first school was authorized in 1976.









Asia Pacific and India IB programme growth

Student enrolment and growth


Nearly 140,000 students from around the world registered for DP exams in 2013. Over 17,000 of those registrants were from the Asia-Pacific region, and over 2,500 of those students took exams in India.


The Diploma programme in India has grown substantially, and over 15,000 Indian students have participated in the IB Diploma Programme in the past twenty years. The number of students participating in the programme in India has grown over 15% each year for the last 5 years, doubling in student enrolment since 2005. A similar trend has been seen in the rest of the region, growing at approximately 15% per year.

Figure 4. Growth in the number of DP exam takers in India and the AP region








Transcript requests data

In 2013, 2208 transcripts were requested by IB Diploma students to be sent to higher education institutions (HEIs) in India for the purpose of university admissions. This makes up to 12.7% of all the transcripts sent to HEIs in the AP region.

Indian passport holders request transcripts sent to HEIs in a variety of countries. Outside of India, the US, the UK, Canada, and Singapore are popular destinations.

Overview of higher education in India

In India, "University" means a University established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial Act or a State Act and includes any such institution in consultation with the University concerned, be recognised by the University Grants Commission (UGC) in accordance with the regulations made in this regard under this Act. Higher Education is the shared responsibility of both the Centre and the States. The Central Government provides grants to UGC and establishes Central Universities in the country. The Central Government is also responsible for declaring educational institutions as "deemed-to-be University" on the recommendation of the UGC.

At present, the main constituents of University/University-level Institutions are: - Central Universities, State Universities, Deemed-to-be Universities and University-level institutions. These are described as follows:

Central University: A university established or incorporated by a Central Act.

State University: A university established or incorporated by a Provincial Act or by a State Act.

Private University: A university established through a State/Central Act by a sponsoring body viz. A Society registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860, or any other corresponding law for the time being in force in a State or a Public Trust or a Company registered under Section 25 of the Companies Act, 1956.

Deemed-to-be University: An Institution Deemed to be University, commonly known as Deemed University, refers to a high-performing institution, which has been so declared by Central Government under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956.

Institution of National Importance: An Institution established by Act of Parliament and declared as Institution of National Importance.

Institution under State Legislature Act: An Institution established or incorporated by a State Legislature Act.

There are 42 Central universities, 243 State universities, 53 State Private universities, 130 Deemed universities, 33 Institutions of National Importance and five Institutions (established under various State legislations). The number of colleges in 2011 is more than 30,000.



Entry to undergraduate courses is based on the performance in Class 12 examination and or Entrance test. Most of the professional institutes in India today prefer to conduct entrance exams for selecting candidates. The entrance tests are in the month of April/May or June. While some institutes participate in a common entrance exam, others may conduct their own individual entrance exams.

Engineering

Technical education plays a vital role in human resource development of the country, Technical Education covers programmes in engineering, technology, management, architecture, town planning, pharmacy, applied arts & crafts, hotel management and catering technology. There are 82 technical institutions in India, which include 16 Indian Institute of Technology (IIT's), 30 National Institute of Technology amongst others.

For undergraduate programmes in IITs students are admitted on the basis of Indian Institute of Technology-Joint Entrance Examination (IIT-JEE). From the year 2013 the Joint Entrance Examination for admission would be conducted in two parts, conducted in two parts, JEE-MAIN and JEE-ADVANCED. JEE ADVANCED examination will be held after JEE MAIN with a suitable time gap. Only the top 150,000 candidates (including all categories) in JEE MAIN will be qualified to appear in the JEE Advanced examination. Admissions to IITs will be based only on category wise All India Rank (AIR) in JEE ADVANCED subject to condition that such candidates are in the top 20 percentile of successful candidates of their Boards in applicable categories. Admission to Undergraduate Engineering Programs at NITs, IIITs, Other centrally funded Technical Institutions, Institutions funded by several participating State Governments, and several other Institutions is also done through Joint Entrance Examination, JEE (Main).

Medicine

From 2013 there is a single Eligibility and Entrance Examination, namely, National Eligibility and Entrance Test (NEET) for admission to MBBS and BDS Course in each academic year.

There is a requirement to study three sciences for studying medicine in India. Whilst it is quite difficult to complete an IB diploma and take three IB science subjects, it is possible. Two options: The first option is to take an additional science subject as an 'extra' certificate. Although obviously this will come with extra work, the overall score for this extra course will not count towards the IB diploma score, and therefore the utility of taking the extra course is simply to satisfy the entrance requirements for the university requiring three sciences. The second option is to apply for a non-regular IB diploma, thus allowing three sciences to be completed, usually in lieu of a group 3 (Humanities) subject. A candidate may be authorized to take a non-regular diploma only if the



proposed higher education course allows no other alternative. You will need to contact the IB coordinator at the school to proceed with this request. Please note that this request must be submitted to the IB Cardiff office (via the IB coordinator) at least 18 months prior to the examinations, and there is no guarantee that such a request will be automatically be granted. Also worth noting is that taking three sciences only helps meet the minimum entry requirements for studying Medicine in most colleges; it does not guarantee entry. Students often will have to sit the entrance test which may require additional tutorials.

Other professional courses

Law, Hotel Management, and Bachelor of Business Administration also have the entrance test.

Accreditation

National Assessment and Accreditation Council, was established by the University Grants Commission to evaluate the quality of higher education in India. In addition to that, Professional councils are responsible for recognition of courses, promotion of professional institutions and providing grants to undergraduate programmes and various awards. There are 15 professional councils in India including All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE) which recognizes technical education in India and Medical Council of India (MCI) recognizes Medical education in India amongst others. Before enrolling for a professional course, students must check if the institute has the relevant accreditation.

Evaluation of Foreign Degrees

The Association of Indian Universities is a society which promotes universities activities. The Evaluation division of AIU is responsible for the work relating to equivalence of degrees/certificates awarded by the accredited foreign universities/educational institutions. The Division also provides information to foreign students to facilitate their admission in Universities/other educational Institutions in the country.

Recognition of the IB Programmes in India

Since 1983 **International Baccalaureate Diploma** has been recognized by the Association of Indian universities as an entry qualification to all universities in India. With the requirement for percentage conversion by universities in India, students applying to Indian universities receive a transcript with IB grades and suggested percentages. In order to receive Indian Transcripts, students must notify their Diploma Programme (DP) coordinator of their intention to gain entrance into an Indian university. The coordinator will then submit the request using the Request for results service on IBIS (secured website for IB coordinators).

Students applying to Indian Universities can apply for an equivalence certificate from AIU upon release of their results, or apply directly to the eligibility department of the university they wish to attend.

Admission to most university courses is based on the academic achievement in Class 12 or entrance test. Entry requirements vary from university to university and course to course. Prior to commencing the DP, students and parents must be familiar with the required subject combinations and levels for the student's future career path; this should ensure students' eligibility for particular professional courses. A student interested in studying an undergraduate course must make direct contact with the college or university he or she would like to attend to check specific course and entry requirements.

Association of Indian Universities equates International Baccalaureate **Middle Years Programme** with grade 10 of an India Board Assessment. Students having completed the MYP are now entitled to apply for admission for higher studies in any school in India



Documents required for admission to Indian Universities

- Indian transcript and Migration certificate issued upon release of results, sent to the DP coordinator at the school. (for students to get the documents from the IB, a request for an Indian transcript should be made through IBIS by the Diploma coordinator
- Character Certificate from school if applicable
- Transfer certificate from School if applicable

Note: Since admission to most colleges in India take place much before the results are released, it may help for students to ask the school to issue a letter stating the date of results release. Students must also take a copy of predicted grades with past performance in a sealed envelope for universities

In this connection we would like to inform you that "International Baccalaureate Diploma" awarded by the International Baccalaureate Organization, Geneva, Switzerland, has been equated with +2 stage (Grade 12) qualification of an Indian Board since 1983.

Students intending to join Indian Universities after completion of their IB qualifications are eligible to pursue Bachelor's degree programme at Indian Universities.

Those intending to join Professional Degree programmes at Indian Universities viz. medicine/engineering etc. are required to have studied the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics and English at the qualifying level.

Students after obtaining their IB Diploma can obtain an Equivalence Certificate from this office which is issued on a remittance of equivalent amount of US \$ 200, in Indian currency, in the form of Demand Draft only, favouring the 'ASSOCIATION OF INDIAN UNIVERSITIES', payable at the New Delhi branch of the issuing bank.

Overseas Students and others who may have qualified through Indian/Foreign Boards

Q. May I join LSR College if I have completed the International Baccalaureate or other equivalent programme?

A. Yes. Admission requests from students who have undergone the International Baccalaureate programme/other equivalent programme are accepted. Our admission process starts in early June and completes by end Jun every year. During this period it is advisable for the student to be present in Delhi.

The Admissions Procedure page on our website gives details of the admissions requirements for overseas students who may be Indian/Foreign nationals including for those who may have qualified through an Indian/Foreign Board.

We entertain the predicted grades as a basis for admission provisionally, subject to merit, vacancies for the course selected.

There are no vacancies reserved for any category in LSR except OBC category.

In case of delay in publishing of the IB results beyond 30 Jun, a confidential assessment of the candidate's capabilities, expected grades and chances of passing the IB programme are required to be sent by the Principal of the prospective student's school/college, to our College Principal, latest by 30 Jun.

We offer only a Bachelor of Arts programme. The list of courses which qualify for admission is included in the Admission Form which may be downloaded from the website as a guide. There is no requirement for prospective students to approach the Foreign Students Adviser if they are an Indian nationals.

Since, the said qualifications have been considered eligible for the admission to first year degree course in the affiliated colleges of this University its Departments. Those principals of the affiliated colleges and Directors/Head of the University Departments who have admitted such students are requested to forward the attested xerox copy of final year marksheet issued to them by the International Baccalaureate / Cambridge International School to this office for taking necessary action.

They are also requested not to admit the student for the various courses without obtaining a proper provisional statement of eligibility certificate as per the provision made under Ordinance 111 of the University. The Ordinance 111 is reproduced below.

A student from another University or Board of Secondary or 0.111 :-Intermediate Education or any other Statutory examining body seeking admission to the University shall apply to the Registrar for a statement of eligibility and except in the case of students from the Universities in the State of Maharashtra, who shall be required to pay fee of Rs.200/- only and for out of Maharashtra State pay a fee of Rs.300/- (Fee for the foreign Nationals is Rs.730/-). The Registrar may issue a provisional statement of eligibility if he is satisfied that the applicant is prima facie eligible for admission to this University. On production of such a provisional statement of eligibility, a student may seek provisional admission to this University at his own risk and on condition that he submits to the Registrar's office through the Head/Principal of his Institution/College, the necessary certificates in original together with a typed copy of each for confirmation of his eligibility before the close of the academic term in which the student is provisionally admitted to the University. No student from another University shall be admitted to any Institution maintained by or affiliated to the University except on production of a provisional statement of eligibility issued by the Registrar.





Candidates seeking admission to the BMS course at St. Xavier's are required to appear for an entrance test conducted by the College. The entrance test will be held in this College sometime in the first week of June 2013. (Details of the entrance test are given separately on the College website). Therefore, candidates should first register for the entrance test through the online system on the 'homepage' of the College website: www.xaviers.edu.

The online system willbe activated on the 1st of May 2013. The last date for registration is 1st June, 2013. Candidates appearing for the Class XII Board Examinations (Maharashtra State Board) or ISC/CBSE (Delhi Board) or any other qualifying examination equivalent to class XII to be held in 2013 including foreign Board i.e. International Baccalaureate (IB) or those who have completed "A" Level from Cambridge and such other Universities are allowed to register for the entrance test in the absence of the Class XII final results. However, candidates will be required to submit an attested copy of their class XII Board marksheet on the day of the entrance test i.e. in June 2013. The qualifying marks to appear for the entrance test is 60% marks at the class XII Board examinations for candidates belonging to the General Category, 55% marks for candidates belonging to Christian Minority and 50% marks for candidates belonging to the Reserve category.

Further, candidates will be shortlisted to appear for an interview before a panel based on the scores he/she obtains at the entrance test which are scaled down to 60% and on their class XII marks which are scaled down to 20% thus arriving a total of 80% for the purpose of interview. Hence, the merit list for admission for the First Year BMM course is based on the total scores he/she obtains at the entrance test (60%), marks obtained in the Std. XII Exam

 Circular No. MSHB/2005/1339/CHH, dated 23-12-2005 of Education Department.

PREAMBLE:

That necessary instructions have been issued for obtaining No-Objection Certificate (NOC) in the Circular mentioned herein above under the head of Read (1) in accordance with bylaws of related Boards of Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools, which intend to affiliate with C.B.S.E./I.C.S.E and others boards of Government of India. At present, there are no instructions / provisions for obtaining No-Objection Certificate



(NOC) for affiliation with other Boards except the State Government and Government of India and as a result of which, there is delay in issuance of No-Objection Certificate to the schools, which intend to have such affiliation.

The education sector / segment has also been considered as separate investment sector in Global Investment Summit – 2009 held by the State Government and considering the same, it is desirable to have healthy competition to improve quality of the education. For this purpose, the matter regarding framing of universal policy in respect of speedy issuance of No-Objection Certificate and Equivalence to the schools, which intend to affiliate with the Boards of Government of India and International Board (International Baccalaureate, Geneva or Cambridge University, London) or other Boards was under the consideration of the Government.

RESOLUTION:

After careful consideration, it is resolved that "No-Objection Certificate" shall be issued to the schools which intend to affiliate with C.B.S.E., I.C.S.E. Board of Government of India and International Board (International Baccalaureate, Geneva or Cambridge University, London) or other Boards subject to following conditions.

- (1) The institute shall make an application with information as stated in the Schedule-1, which is annexed herewith, to the Secretary, Gujarat Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board, Gandhinagar for obtaining "No-Objection Certificate" (NOC). The Gujarat Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board will decide the fees to be paid along with such application. The standard of fee shall be remained same and equal for all Boards as mentioned in the preamble. The institute shall produce undertaking along with the application that the institute will fully follow the rules and regulations of the respective Board.
- (2) The Gujarat Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board,
 Gandhinagar shall verify and examine such application and shall
 forward proposal with the information mentioned in the Schedule-2
 to the Government. If it finds necessary, the information in respect
 of the following matters shall be called for from the concerned
 District Educational Officer. That no verification in respect of the
 rules and regulations of the respective Board shall be made by
 Gujarat Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board, State
 Board.

- The matters relating to B.U. Permission, local taxes etc.
- (2) Whether the place, where the school is to be started / opened, is suitable in view of the health and hygiene ? Yes/No. If no, reasons for it.
- (3) Whether the school building is suitable in view of safety and security? (For example, whether safety and security measurements have been taken in the event of abnormal situation such as fire, earthquake? Yes / No. If no, reasons for it.
- (4) Is there any bar in implementing any local laws for opening the school at the proposed place of school ? Yes / No. If yes, reasons for it.
- (3) The Board shall call for information from the concerned District Educational Officer, only if it finds necessary, within 10 working days from the date of receipt of such application from the institute and the concerned District Educational Officer shall verify the place personally and shall submit full details / clear opinion within 10 working days. If the information sought for is not provided by the District Educational Officer, the Board shall examine the matter through its other officer and shall forward the proposal along with its clear opinion within 30 working days without fail.
- (4) The aforesaid procedure mentioned in (3) for obtaining No Objection Certificate (NOC) shall be completed <u>within the period of 45 working days</u>. This time limit can be extended for <u>60 working days</u> only in special case. The "No-Objection Certificate" shall be issued with the approval of the Chief Secretary (Agra Sachiv) (Education).
- (5) The "No-Objection Certificate" (NOC) issued to the applicant institute shall be remained valid **for the period of six months.** The concerned school shall have responsibility to obtain affiliation with the board during such time limit. If such is not done, the applicant Institute shall make an application with reasonable reasons within time limit of six months for extension of time limit for further six months of "No Objection Certificate" (NOC). If such application is



not received by the Government within time limit of six months, the "No Objection Certificate" shall be deemed to have been automatically cancelled.

- (6) The applicant Institute shall produce certified copy of the certificate in respect of its affiliation with the Board before the State Government and the Gujarat Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board within the time limit as mentioned in the aforesaid (5).
- (7) The State Government shall not take responsibility, financially, administratively or in any other way, for the applicant institute after the issuance of "No-Objection Certificate" (NOC) to the applicant institute.
- (8) The institutes, which are affiliated with other Board by obtaining "No-Objection Certificate", shall make its registration before Gujarat Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board, Gandhinagar by producing certified copy of its affiliation certificate. If the pupils of such registered institutes intend to go in the State Board, the procedure for issuance of Equivalence certificate shall be followed



by Gujarat Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board, Gandhinagar. If the institute does not make its registration with Gujarat Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board, Gandhinagar, the Board shall have no responsibility to issue Equivalence Certificate.

- (9) The complaints received in respect of the matters mentioned in the aforesaid Sub-Para (1), (2), (3) and (4) of Para (2), its verification / examination can be made by the District Educational Officer and the report prepared in this regard shall be submitted to the concerned Central / International Board through Gujarat Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board for necessary action.
- (10) The Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi have framed certain rules and regulations and guidelines for consideration of equivalence of different Boards of the Government of India and also for other Boards and also for result of examination of standard 12th conducted by such boards. All the universities situated in the State of Gujarat shall follow such rules and regulations and guidelines for the purpose of giving admission for higher education / stream and shall give instructions to follow such rules to its

colleges. The Education Department shall be informed in this regard for acceptance of instructions of this resolution within the maximum period of six months.

(11) The circular dated 23-12-2005 of this department mentioned in the preamble is hereby repealed.

However, each Board/University is at liberty to put eligibility conditions for the next stage e.g. Class XI or the 1st year of college or a professional course. In other words equivalence is only equating two examinations and Eligibility may have additional conditions prescribed by the Board/University

As regards the toreign qualifications, this Board accepts the recognition/equivalence determined by Association of Indian Universities, AIU House, 16, Comrade Indrajeet Gupta Marg, New Delhi. AIU have recognized for purpose of admission to higher studies in India the qualifications of about 85 countries all of which are listed country wise in the AIU publication Equivalence of Foreign Degrees". Once the terminal exams stand recognized, the lower qualifications are automatically acceptable after verification of the original authenticated certificates/documents.

AN INTRODUCTION:

The Inter University Board (IUB) was established in 1925 and was renamed as the ASSOCIATION OF INDIAN UNIVERSITIES (AIU) in 1973. The need of an organization in India for equivalence of degrees between the universities in India and abroad was felt since long, after the establishment of three premier Universities (Bombay, Calcutta and Madras in 1857) and therefore, the Inter University Board was formed as an Autonomous Body.

The Evaluation Division was also established ever since with the inception of IUB/AIU.

Evaluation Division was entrusted with the task of recognition and assessment of degrees and diplomas awarded by the recognized Universities in India and abroad for purpose of admission to higher studies. This is one of the main objectives that AIU took upon itself and since been carrying out effectively for the last eighty five years.

AIU is the only recognized body in India for granting academic equivalence of degrees/diplomas not only within the country but also to other similar bodies in foreign countries.

In acknowledgement to the works done by the Division since its inception the Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi, vide their letter No. Dated 13th May, 1995 issued a Notification that the equivalence done by AIU will be valid for the purpose of higher education as well as employment in the country.

Since then the Division started issuing Equivalence Certificates to individuals and till date the Division is facilitating the Universities also in granting Admission to various degree level programmes.

Not only to the Universities, AIU also provides its services, for equivalence of degrees to various Central & State Employment agencies viz Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi and State Recruitment Boards.

The Division, besides Ministry of Human Resource Development, GOI, also facilitates to other Federal Ministries of India, to formulate the proposals on mutual recognition of degrees under Educational Exchange Programmes.

The Division continues to provide assistance on the status of foreign qualifications to Universities, Ministries of the Government of India, Union Public Service Commission, Indian Council for Cultural Relations and other Agencies concerning with the nomination/selection of foreign students in Indian Universities. The application forms of all the foreign students who are sponsored under various Central Government Scholarships/Ministries are sent to us, in order to assess their eligibility, to the courses in which they are seeking admission in Indian Universities. As the Division has established accountability as a reliable accrediting source/agency on the assessment/certification of equivalence of qualifications, we receive a number of enquiries from Credential Evaluation Service Agencies in other countries, as well.



+2 LEVEL QUALIFICATIONS

Since AIU has already accorded equivalence to the Secondary stage qualification of most of the countries, world over, the students having obtained foreign qualifications do not face any problem to join Bachelor's degree programmes at Indian Universities.

However, there are a few countries, whose +2 level qualification have not been accorded equivalence due to their deficient system of school education i.e. Philippines, Myanmar etc. while some of them — Denmark, Greece, Algeria, Bolivia etc. have never approached us.

In case the system of education, duration of the course (i.e. 10+2/3) and the nomenclature of the Certificate issued on completion of the programme, is similar to those we have already accorded equivalence, AIU accords equivalence to +2 level qualifications.

It would also be appropriate to mention here that AIU accepts the 10 year Secondary and 12 year Higher Secondary/Intermediate/Pre-University/Senior Secondary Examinations conducted by the approved Boards, whose names have been included in the list brought out by the Council of Boards of School Education in India (COBSE), Delhi.

The following is a list of +2 level qualifications recognized by AIU and their nomenclatures:

Candidates intending to j oin Professional courses are required to have passed the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics in ADVANCED LEVEL & English at AS LEVEL.
- v) 12 Year High School Diploma from accredited Schools of USA
- vi) Intermediate/Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary examinations of the approved Boards in Pakistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan and Nepal
- vii) 12 year Secondary Stage qualification of National Examinations Board of the Ministry of Education, Ethiopia, Sudan.
- viii) 12-year Secondary Stage examination conducted by various Provinces in *Canada and Australia
- ix) * * GCE "Ordinary and Advanced" level examination of the Department of Education, Government of Sri Lanka, Singapore, Hong Kong & Mauritus.
- x) 12 year STPM examination of Malaysia
- xi) 12 year Secondary Stage qualification of Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Republic of Vietnam and Yemen Arab Republic
- xii) "Abitur" examination of Germany
- xiii) *** 12 year High School Diploma awarded by the accredited American Schools/International Schools in other countries following American System of Education.

- XX) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination with minimum 2 (Two) Principal Passes & 2(Two) Subsidiary Passes of the National Examinations Council of Tanzania.
- XXI) Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education Examination with minimum 2 (Two) Principal Passes & 2(Two) Subsidiary Passes of the Uganda Examinations Board
- Candidate having passed Ontario Secondary School Diploma of the Ministry of Education, Ontario should have acquired minimum 6 (Six) "U/M" (University Preparatory Courses).




Fig 3.1 Screen of "www.aviacac.nic.in"




Fig. 3.2 Screen of "New Registration Window"
